

## Beef Instructions

### What you need to know to call in beef instructions:

Any cuts of meat you do not want will go towards your hamburger

- Brisket – Y or N
- Short Ribs – Y or N
- Roasts - Y or N If yes,
  - All or Best only
  - Size (2 – 3 pounds or 3 – 4 pounds)
- Round Steaks – Y or N If Yes
  - Tenderized, Not Tenderized, or Minute Steaks
  - If minute steaks – how many per package? (2 or more)
- Sirloin Steaks – Y or N If yes,
  - How thick ( ½” up to 1 ½” )
  - How many per package ( 1 or more)
- Choose T-bones or Filet and KC strips - Y or N If yes,
  - (T-bones are bone in, filet and kc are boneless)
  - How thick ( ½” up to 1 ½” )
  - How many per package (2 or more)
- Choose Rib Steaks, or Ribeyes If yes,
  - (Rib steaks are bone in, ribeyes are boneless)
  - How thick ( ½” up to 1 ½” )
  - How many per package (2 or more)
- Hamburger
  - Package size – 1; 1 1/2; or 2 lb. package.
- Hamburger Patties – Y or N (we have a minimum of twenty pounds)
- Stew Meat – Y or N
- Soup Bones – Y or N
